Alcohol Policy

1. *The Cambridge University Granta Rats* (hereafter referred to as “the Society”) is not a drinking society.
2. Excessive drinking is strongly discouraged at all events or gatherings associated or identified with the Society.
3. Members are reminded of Article **3.5** of the Society’s Constitution:

3.5 The Executive Committee may expel any member from the Society whose conduct seems likely to bring the Society into disrepute. Such expulsion will be subject to confirmation at the next General Meeting of the Society.

3.5.1 It is herein advised that the committee shall take notice of any conduct or behaviour exhibited by members or non-members bearing club insignia as they shall of any participants of events associated or identified with the Society.

4. Members are prohibited from punting, rowing or in any other way piloting any vessel while drunk.
5. Members are strictly prohibited from entering water for the purpose of swimming after the consumption of alcohol.
6. Drinking games and penalties or forfeits demanding the consumption of alcohol are forbidden at all events organised by the Society.
7. This Policy may be reviewed at any time by the Executive Committee. Any alterations must be passed unanimously all members of the Committee, and ratified by at least a two thirds majority at a General Meeting.
